

Airlift Northwest's fleet of fixed wing turboprop aircraft are now based in Central Washington. The Pilatus PC-12 flies at 292 mph and has a range of 800 miles. It is ideal for the shorter runways at local municipal airports.

The PC-12 has anti-icing capabilities which allow it to operate during inclement weather. It often backs up the rotary wing fleet by rendezvousing at nearby airports when weather is a factor.

The PC-12 is equipped to care for neonatal, pediatric and adult patients of all types, including bariatric.
